

**The following motions were approved as resolutions at the IBPO National Convention held September 10 – 13, 2006.**

- ❖ NAGE Charities
  - That each local of NAGE/IBPO be obligated to raise a dollar per member per year to support NAGE Charities.
- ❖ NAGE/IBPO Scholarship Program
  - That each local of NAGE/IBPO be obligated to raise a dollar per member per year to support the NAGE/IBPO Scholarship Program.
- ❖ “The Law Enforcement Museum”
  - That NAGE/IBPO budget ten thousand dollars per year to match up to that amount funds raised by IBPO locals in support of “The Law Enforcement Museum” and that each IBPO local be obligated to raise a dollar per member per year.
- ❖ “Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc”
  - That NAGE/IBPO budget five thousand dollars per year to match up to that amount funds raised by IBPO locals in support of “Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc.” and that each IBPO local be obligated to raise a dollar per member per year.
- ❖ Absentee Voting at National Convention
  - If this resolution is allowed by the Department of Labor, NAGE/IBPO will allow duly elected delegates of local unions to vote by absentee ballot on the election of officers.

Any delegate who is unable to attend the convention shall notify the election officer 30 days before the start of the convention.

Absentee ballot shall be signed by duly elected delegates and notarized and shall be mailed by certified mail within three weeks of the receipt of the official ballot from the National Election Officer.

Absentee ballots must be received by the election officer seven days prior to the start of the convention and shall remain unopened in the custody of the election officer until the National Convention.

Absentee ballots will be certified, opened, and counted at the convention immediately upon conclusion of the voting by delegates present at the convention.
- ❖ Dues Increase
  - That the National President be authorized to increase each local’s dues by the sum of \$2.00 per member per week.

❖ COPE

- In order to meet our commitment to the political process and the SEIU mandates, each NAGE/IBPO/IBCO/IAEP local should meet their COPE commitment by raising 50 cents per member per month.
  
- In addition, each local should raise an additional \$20 dollars per member over the next two years to be directed to the SEIU COPE program for the 2008 Presidential election.
